EVENING CLASS

- Course: **Serving Together: God's Truth and Power** Earl Burton
- Course Description: This evening series of teachings is designed to present: God's Word is Truth. God has given His Word so we could know His Will. The knowledge from God tells us all things that pertain unto life and godliness. God's Word is sharp and powerful. God has given to all Christians the gift of holy spirit which is power from on high. God has equipped His people with truth and power so they can stand together, serve God and one another together as they enjoy the more than abundant life.
- Teachers: Daniel Bader, Art Poling, Barbara Sugue, Joe Suminski, Gerald Wrenn and Earl Burton

MORNING CLASSES

- Course: **America's Biblical Founding** Tom & Nancy Jenkinson
- Course Description: This class is based on the book: [AMERICA, The Biblical Foundation Revealed](#) by Tom Jenkinson. This class is a "God's Word in" presentation. (Like God's Word in business or in the Arts or in athletics, etc.) It documents the Scriptural background and considerations of the founders of America. It includes an examination of how Biblical truths were the basis of many decisions that shaped the history of the USA through the lives of famous and not so famous colonial patriots. This course will provide an opportunity for the students to gain a greater appreciation of how God was at work in the lives of many of the American colonial settlers. It is inspirational and practical for the Christian believer of today.
- Teachers: Tom and Nancy both come from a teaching background. Tom taught high school American History and Government. Nancy taught various business classes in high school and college. Combined they have over 50 years of Christian service. They have taught in home fellowships as well as in other various Christian group settings.

Course: **From Death to Victory** Kevin Browning

Course Description: “From Death to Victory” is an overview of the cause and consequences of Adam’s fall, God’s loving plan and solution to redeem mankind by way of Jesus Christ, and our wonderful hope of Christ’s return. We will also cover the events surrounding the end of the age, as well as the Christian’s inheritance and reward. The goal of this class is to give an overview of these events, so that we can marvel, rejoice, and give appreciation and thanksgiving to our God for the wonderful hope that we all have as Christians.

Teacher: Kevin Browning is the teacher for this class. Kevin has worked this topic for decades and is passionate about the subject. He has presented these Biblical truths a number of times at previous Summer Schools.

Course: **Diligently Seeking God** Greg Earle

Course Description: With Hebrews 11:6 as the theme verse, this class will apply the keys as to how Scripture interprets itself to open the student’s understanding that approaching God is well pleasing to Him. Also, it declares that God rewards those that diligently seek Him. This class will include an overview of the book of Hebrews and a close look at those believers who are set forth as examples of believing God. Jesus Christ as the great high priest who offered himself to enable others to come boldly to the throne of grace is especially emphasized.

Teacher: Greg has been a student and teacher of God’s Word for over 40 years. He leads Bible fellowships, conducts weekly Bible Studies on Zoom and assists in the work of the Philadelphia Bible Teaching Fellowship.

Course: **An Education from the Church Epistles** Matthew Stein

Course Description: In this class we will go through each epistle and consider how they provide the attributes of doctrine, reproof and correction for believers. Together these three attributes form proper instruction, education, training in righteousness for believers; “... so that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.” (II Timothy 3:17) Ultimately, each student will grow and gain a greater understanding of all that God has made available through His Son, Jesus Christ.

Teacher: Matt has grown up in a family with strong Scriptural standing. He has been studying the Church Epistles for quite a while and has further developed the material which he taught at Summer School in 2025.

They lived during a period of significant change and faced persistent opposition. This course examines the historical context, languages, religious structures, and influences that were prevalent at the time. It also highlights those believers whose lives were exemplary, encouraging the application of God's Word in the midst of modern day challenges. | |
| Teacher: | Ray is the author of the books: <u>Follow Me; An Introduction to the Gospel and New Testament Believers of the Bible</u> and <u>From God Almighty to You: An Introduction to the Subject of How We Got The Bible</u> . He has led a home fellowship for 40 years and taught at numerous family camps and Biblical seminars. | |
| Course: | The Great Mystery | Ron and Julie Neeffe |
| Course Description: | We will look at many of our new-birth realities, exploring our redemptive realities and the mystery realities. The understanding of our Redemptive realities and the Lordship of Jesus Christ is necessary to fully understand the Mystery. The foundation of the Mystery lies in the understanding of our Redemptive realities and of Jesus Christ being Lord. One must understand our Redemptive realities and the Lordship of Jesus Christ to fully understand the Mystery. | |
| Teachers: | Ron and Julie have studied Greek and Aramaic, and Julie has also studied Hebrew. They have worked on different research projects. After graduating from the Way Corps, Ron and Julie have faithfully taught home Bible Fellowships weekly for over 38 years. One area they have spent time studying and teaching is The Mystery and our new-birth realities among other Biblical subjects. | |
| Course: | The Gospels | Daniel Bader |
| Course Description: | The title expresses the content. The book <u>A Journey Through Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, Volumes I and II</u> by Rev. Daniel Bader will be available soon. It may be ordered from ContinuingintheScriptures.com starting around May 1, 2026. | |

Teacher: Daniel has worked on several Biblical research books Including A Journey Through the Acts and Epistles Volume II. He has also authored books on redemption and love.

Course: **Ignorance? What Does God Want?** Rebeca Assad

Course Description: This course will revolve around the 7 Scriptures stating that of which God does not want believers ignorant. Why are these things singled out by God. How this knowledge will benefit believers and others. How the Scriptures interpret themselves; some Greek word studies and consideration of figures of speech will also be addressed.

Teacher: Rebeca has lived in Canada for the past 38 years. She has coordinated home fellowships, days and weekends in God's Word and assisted numerous Biblical Research classes. She graduated from The Way Corps in 1982. Her teaching travels have taken her to the USA, Canada, Europe and South America.

Course: **Old Testament: A Brief Scope** Art and Linda Poling

Course Description: God's love in bringing to pass the Christ is impeccable, irreproachable, and focused. This class follows the path of the restoration of the relationship between God and man that had been broken by Adam. The Old Testament Scriptures were written beforehand to instruct and encourage us, enabling us to hold fast to real hope through endurance and the comfort that hope brings. It is suggested that students acquire a copy of the book God's Order and Time: A Working Study in Old Testament Chronology by Art and Linda Poling. (Expected to be available at Summer School)

Teacher: Both Art and Linda have been involved in Biblical Research for over 40 years. In recent years they have taught Old Testament Chronology at Summer School and at other locations.

Course: **An Overview of Timothy** Barbara Sague

Course Description: I & II Timothy were written by the Apostle Paul to Timothy a leader in the Church. In I Timothy, Paul charged and exhorted Timothy on how to address problems that had arisen at Ephesus and what would be proper conduct in the Church of the Living God. II Timothy exhorts him to continue rightly dividing the Word of truth and to teach faithful people who could teach others also. Timothy was to guard against those who resist the Word of truth. There are great examples for Church leadership in I & II Timothy.

Teacher: Barbara has studied and taught the Scriptures from her home for 50 years. She holds a degree in theology and has served as an assistant faculty member for Old Testament History, Fundamentals of Research and as a research paper advisor at the Way College in Rome City, Indiana.

Course: **Practical Christianity** Joe and Claire Suminski

Course Description: This class will present practical principles from God's Word so that believers may walk in the new nature. All practical matters must be founded in the right teaching of God's Word. The topics covered include: Giving and Receiving, Stewardship, SIT, Prayer, Believing, Helping Others and Colossians 3:1 – 4:6. Practically applying the Father's instructions to us, His children, is a lifetime endeavor with great reward to us and glory to God.

Teacher: Joe and Claire lead a home fellowship and operate a successful family business. Claire has authored numerous books. They have taught at a number of Summer Schools, conferences, advances, classes and host a Whole Bible Hog Roast every year.

Course: **Renewing the Mind** Owen Fitzpatrick

Course Description: This class is the practical side of the believers walk with and for God. It will help the student learn how to control his or her thinking to recognize their position in Christ as a son of God; to practice the presence of God and to walk in the love of God. Jesus Christ paid the price so God's people could live the more than abundant life.

Teacher: Owen has been a WOW ambassador, fellowship coordinator for many years and hosts a weekly zoom Bible Study night at his house. He has worked this subject and enjoys teaching these truths from God's Word that bless and benefit every believer.

Course: **Romans 9 - 16** Gerald Wrenn

Course Description: Romans 9 – 16 declares the practical application for the doctrinal revelation given in Romans 1 - 8. It teaches how the believer is to function in the Body of Christ as a result of what is taught in Romans 1 – 8.

Teacher: Gerald has been a teacher of God's Word and a leader in the ministry for more than 50 years. He has taught Romans and numerous other topics from God's Word for years

Course: **Thy Will Be Done – A Biblical Foundation for Prayer** Randall Micek

Course Description: The purpose of this class is for students to grow in prayer by learning from the examples of Abraham, Moses, Jesus and Paul. Emphasis will be placed on how to understand and apply I John 5:14b, “if we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us.” Students will acquire easy to use Biblical resources to enable continued growth in their study of prayer.

Teacher: In association with *Scripture Consulting Conference*, Randall led a small team with the aim of learning and confirming what the Bible itself teaches about prayer. With that as the starting point, Randall continued to research the topic of Biblical prayer and in 2023 published the book, *THY WILL BE DONE*, which will be the study guide for this class.
